PONDERING PUB OVERVIEW

This outlines the entire Pondering Pub Organization.

PURPOSE - WHAT IS THE PONDERING PUB?

- The purpose of The Pondering Pub is creating communities that foster the arts.
- In America, especially post-Covid, many people lack any form of community. What "community" they do have is either co-workers whose friendship ends at 5:00 or "communities" based off ideology. Neither of these are genuine.
- What we did is explore how the earliest humans developed communities. What we found was
 most of them became formed through experiences with the Divine.

 So what we do is weekly, we meet at a host's house and discuss works of Truth, Beauty, and Goodness. All 3 of these transcendental values lead to God, and by touching them, we experience the Divine.

PRAXIS

- So what does that look like?
- All good ideas have structure to their manifestation.
- This powerpoint is divided into 3 parts: an overview of the Organization, the layout of an individual Pondering, and the organizational Pondering as a whole.
- The First part will cover how individual ponderings typically run, along with some examples of what has occurred at various Ponderings.
- The Second part will go in depth on how individual Ponderings are structured, along with various policies they must follow, and tips that the leadership think are helpful for Founders.
- The Third part will explain how the larger organizational structure operates.

PART 1

An Overview

OVERVIEW - AN INDIVIDUAL PONDERING

- The Pondering Pub is comprised of various "Pubs" (community meeting places) which host "Ponderings" (events at these community meeting places)
- At a Pondering, any community member may share a work of Truth, Beauty, or Goodness, that they found or created and wish to share with others.
- These meetings are based upon Christ, but the presentations need not focus entirely upon Christianity. Any aspect of Truth, Beauty, or Goodness may be the subject of discussion during a presentation.



EXAMPLE 1: THE DUMB OX

- The Dumb Ox's Pondering
- This Pub is comprised of 9 members. It is a younger crowd, most of them fresh out of college, so they decide to meet at 9:00 PM on Fridays.
- It begins around 9:30, once everyone has finally shown up. Henry leads everyone in prayer.
- Tom plays the guitar. He plays a song he learned on the guitar, and reflects on some lyrics. Other people share their thoughts, and the discussion leads to a reflection of manual labor and intellectual labor.



EXAMPLE 1: THE DUMB OX



- Elizabeth follows. She has been going through a difficult time, and wrote some poetry about it. This is her first time writing poetry, but she wants to communicate this feeling God has given her. She reads it twice.
- Tim claims he isn't creative. But he was reading something one day about time, and thought it valuable. He shared a passage from the book, and asked 2 discussion questions.
 People loved it and the discussion lasted 30 minutes.
- Around 11:30, the presentations end. Since they're all good friends and young, they talk and laugh until well past midnight, and then go home.

EXAMPLE 2: THE STONE AND THE GIANT

- The Stone and the Giant's Pondering
- This Pub is comprised of 15 members, but only 7 can attend on any average night. Its crew is more established, with several members being married and having kids. They need to have their kids in bed by bedtime, so they meet 6:00 Saturday nights.
- People start arriving 5:45. This group decided to have a light meal together. This week, it is Ethan and Lexi's turn to bring food.
- The group says prayers at 6:00, and they have 3 presentations for the evening.



EXAMPLE 2: THE STONE AND THE GIANT



- The first presentation is by Ethan. He enjoys sketching people, and exaggerating certain features to bring out their "true" selves. He shows his art.
- Second is Amy. She is very smart, and wrote a short piece about friendship. She reads it to the group.
- Last is Paul. He saw a YouTube video that made him think. He showed it to the group, and prepared 4 discussion questions in light of what they just watched. The conversation lasts for hours. Those with kids leave when they must, and those without leave around 11.

OVERVIEW OF EXAMPLES

- In all of these examples, some aspect of the Divine must be brought out. Christ must be apparent in all of these. In Toms' song, he brought out the goodness that comes from genuine, God-honoring labor. In Amy's literature on friendship, she argued for the Truth of friendship being necessary.
- The general premise went: People gathered at a house, shared cultural works of Truth, Beauty, and Goodness, and they enjoyed each other's company.

PART 2

Ponderings at the Individual Level

INDIVIDUAL PONDERING STRUCTURE

- Rules aren't needed for when things are good. They come in handy when things are bad. Here are the structures that constitute a Pondering:
- Local Leadership
 - All Pubs are comprised of 2 leadership positions: Host and Pub Representative.
 - Host Provides the physical location for the Pondering. Decides how the Prayer is said. Sets any House rules that must be followed. Schedules Ponderings.
 - Pub Rep Is the Point-of-Contact between that Pub and the greater Pondering Leadership. Also sets the agenda of the evening. Aids in the "flow" of the Pondering. Organizes the night.

INDIVIDUAL PONDERING STRUCTURE

- Agenda
 - Prayer
 - Announcements
 - Presentations
 - Art
 - Music
 - Literature
 - Powerpoint
 - Discussions
 - Close

INDIVIDUAL PONDERING COMMUNICATION

- The Pub leadership decides how often, when, and where Ponderings occur.
- Each Pub falls under a region led by an Area Leadership Team. The Area Leadership
 Team provides resources, strategies, and support for Ponderings that fall under their
 umbrella.
 - The Area Pub Leadership should meet with each individual Pub leadership team once a quarter. This ensures things are running smoothly. If there are issues, the Area Leadership uses its network of resources to aid that individual Pondering.
 - The Pub Rep is the primary point of contact for the Area Leadership Team.

INDIVIDUAL PONDERING LEGAL

- If members of a Pondering would like to have their work published on the website or other social media platforms, they may submit their content through the website.
- If a Pondering itself would like to have their own social media page, please consult your Pub Rep.
- Individual Ponderings may NOT collect money. This is because we are a non-profit and this
 messes with our taxes.
- Individual Ponderings are subject to any policies or bylaws their Area Leadership Team passes. This is required for legal reasons.
 - If an Area Leadership Team passes a policy that an individual Pub feels unjust, they may petition it. Contact your Pub Rep.

FOUNDER'S TIPS: SIZE

- The ideal Pondering size is between 4-10 people.
 - Any fewer than 4 people, and we've found it's hard to consistently bring new ideas to the table
 - Any larger than 10 people, and people get left out of the main conversation.
 - 6 is the ideal size
- Ponderings should have a "core group" of about 8-10 people. But 15-20 people consistently invited.
 - This is because of the core group, 75% typically are able to come. Of the larger group, 1 or 2 people sometimes show up.

PART 3

The Pondering Pub at the Organizational Level

ORGANIZATIONAL LEVEL: OVERVIEW

The Pondering Pub is divided into 3 parts: The Board, The Staff, and The Leadership.

- · Board provides strategy and measurable checkpoints to grow the Pondering
- The Staff- carries out the functions of the Board.
- The Leadership where all the individual ponderings, area leadership teams, and Ponderings are ran.
- Leaders run the individual ponderings and are where all the attention is directed. Whenever a
 leader runs into an issue, the staff creates resources to help them address it. The board is there to
 provide overarching decisions and assist The Pondering Pub comply with legal and financial
 requirements.

Board

Provides Strategies and direction for the Pondering as a whole

Meets 2 times a year

(Some people are apart of multiple parts of leadership)

Executes the strategy of the Board Fundraising, creating promotional videos, assisting Founders


What the Pondering Pub is all about

PONDERINGS: HIERARCHY

- For administrative purposes, the Pondering is broken up into 3 tiers.
- Area Leadership teams preside over a region. They aid new Founders start pubs, and help keep alive current ones.
- There will be multiple Ponderings that fall under one Area Leadership Team.



PONDERING HIERARCHY: AREA LEADERSHIP TEAM

- The Area Leadership Team is comprised of a President, VP, Secretary, and Treasurer.
 - These people are allowed to collect money for the Pondering, aid in administration, and are responsible for all legal occurrences within their areas.
- They are to meet with each Pub Rep in their area at least once every three months. Both to aid in mentorship, morale, and resources.
- The president of each Area Leadership Team is to give a report at all board meetings.
